A message from George F. Heinrich, M.D. and Sandra Brown-Sherman, Esq.

On behalf of the Board of Directors, we are pleased to announce that **New Jersey Health** Foundation is launching its next cycle of Research Grants Program funding and will be accepting applications from September 6, 2016 through November 7, 2016. We have committed \$1 million for this current cycle.

Through this program, in its 26th year, **New Jersey Health** Foundation (NJHF) has awarded more than \$56 million in grants to advance promising research.

For this round of funding, full-time faculty members and personnel at these organizations are eligible to apply for the grants of up to \$35,000 each:

- Kessler Foundation
- New Jersey Institute of Technology
- Princeton University
- Rowan University
- Rutgers University
- Stevens Institute of Technology

Policies & Procedures, criteria, a sample Letter of Agreement, FAQs and other pertinent information can be found on the New Jersey Health Foundation web site along with a link to the application portal. Prior to submission to NJHF, all applicants must follow their organization's standard approval protocols and procedures. Grant applications can then be submitted directly to **New Jersey Health** Foundation electronically and will be reviewed by the **New Jersey Health** Foundation Research Grants Committee.

Submission to NJHF does not guarantee grant funding.

Awardees will initially receive 80% of their grant award. The remaining 20% will be provided upon submission and NJHF acceptance of final narrative and financial reports. If the final 20% is needed to complete the project, interim progress and financial reports can be submitted electronically through the application portal to New Jersey Health Foundation at any time prior to completion of the project.
