



New Jersey Health Foundation (NJHF) has awarded more than **\$1 million** in its latest funding cycle to advance health-related research in New Jersey. Each of the thirty-one selected applicants (total applicants of 183) will receive up to \$35,000. Historically, NJHF has awarded more than \$58 million in research grants to promote inventive science projects in the State of NJ.
